

## Public Speaking and Presentation Skills for Adults

This course in Public Speaking and Presentation Skills is closely modeled to the Trinity Guildhall examination syllabus in Communication Skills.

Students will be guided to accomplish tasks which will build on their ability to engage with analytic and critical thoughts, to persuade, negotiate and explain ideas in a logical and coherent manner.

Students will learn how to listen with care, speak with clarity and understanding, and distinguish between informative and persuasive speaking. They will also learn how to use an appropriate range of verbal and non-verbal skills for effective communication in a variety of situations. Students will understand how to present information, ideas and opinions coherently and interact with individuals, groups and/or audiences.

Through the course, students will be guided to deliver detailed presentations using a variety of aids, and encouraged to use spoken language more vividly and powerfully. Their level of confidence and clarity of communication should improve with time and practice.

Students can choose to take Trinity Guildhall examinations at the appropriate grade in due course, or opt to continue with classes that will build on the different skills and competencies required through the grades without taking formal assessments.
